There are no fees for the class – it is presented as a service of the Cullman County Sheriff's Office.

Applications must be received no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, December 11, 2009.

Class size is limited to 30 class members. When this class is full, applicants will be scheduled for the next session.

Letters of acceptance will be sent to all applicants selected to attend the Sheriff's Citizens Academy.

All classes are held on Tuesday evenings from 6:00-9:00 pm.

A ride-along with one of our Deputies will be scheduled for each class member.

Firearms Safety and Basic Marksmanship Principles will be included in the class. A firing range exercise will be scheduled on a Saturday after this class for those who want to bring their own handguns and try out their new-learned skills.

Members of the Cullman County Sheriff's Office will be the primary instructors for most classes. The Cullman County 911 Board, the District Attorney's office, the District Court, and the Circuit Court of Cullman County will provide guest instructors for certain special classes.
